



#### Turn the pyramid around to minimise the impact of ERP pitfalls

Highly Customized, On-Prem, **most** processes and requirements has been treated as **unique**.


Focused on Industry best practice processes **minimizing** unique and resource heavy requirements









## PI for CloudSuite Industrial Enterprise
