

## What is Facets


- Facets is a capability within search engines and is a count per value in a specific field based on entered search query
- Is a high-performance solution
- Often used as a filter to find right group of items in a web shop
- Often it includes both a description and the number of records of the specific value based on the other selected filters.
- Examples are from Infor Sales Hub and Systembolaget.se





## Additional usage of Facets in M3

- Used both for statistics of selected information as well as fast performing aggregation
- Used in both standard homepages/workspaces and Experience designer apps.








## **Enhancement to facets in M3**

A new API transaction has been delivered

- Includes the description of the facet value
- Default in user language but can be changed by stating a different language
- Uses BROWSEMI to retrieve the description.






## Facets and Experience designer

Experience designer is creating additional usage of facets

- Drive a selection list including number of records
- Simple drill around to view statistics, use links to details etc
- Browse and only see possible values that also exist in the selected table (requires that browsed field exists as a facet in the used table)






## Facets and Experience designer

#### Browse with facets

- Displays only the values that exists in the table (for used search)
- Displays the number of records for each value
- For future it will be possible to select fields to display and override header





### Facets and search metadata

#### Fields to be usable as facets

- Part of the search metadata delivered from infor
- Test which fields in a table that can be used as facets via MDP and FACETMI
  - Play with the query field to limit the response to see all facet fields
